## DISASSEMBLY

- 1 the connect steering imper (if equipped) from centerlink. Check steering damper for lag or dead
- 2. Remove the coties and slotted nuts from the inner tie rod ends, idler arm and pitman arm. Break tapers using a suitable taper breaker.
- 2 Pemove centralink from vehicle.

## ASSEMBLY

- Replacement centerlink has bracket for steering damper. Original centerlink may or may not to this bracket. Bracket does not affect fit or function of the centerlink.
  - to the sent centerlink in vehicle and attach inner tie rod ends. Install all slotted nuts and temper to 40-72 ft.-lbs. (54-98 N-m). Always tighten the slotted nut further to align the cotter pin.
- 2. Exemnect steering damper (if equipped).
- 3. A root end alignment is recommended.

These parts are not designed for installation on rehicles where the suspension and/or steering systems have been modified for racing, competition, or any other purpose.

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
